Each team is required to provide either a time keeper, thirty second clock operator or a score sheet volunteer for their scheduled games.

*Round Robin Games (Thursday, Friday, Saturday) (includes all mini-games if req.)*

Home team: Score-sheet and thirty second clock operator.

Away team: Time-keeper.

*Semi-Final Games & Final Games (Sunday)*

The tournament committee will be supplying the time-keeper, score keepers and shot clock operators for all divisions.

Coaches: Please make sure the volunteer you provide is knowledgeable in the task they are asked to perform.

**Game Sheets:**

Please have all coaching staff sign in at the Host Table no later than 30 minutes to game start time.

Game sheet copies can be picked up at the host table after all sheets and fair play ballots have been received. Do not separate any game sheets. All sheets must be handed back into the host table.

**Fair Play Awards:**

Attached to each game sheet are two fair play ballots that must be filled out by each team at the completion of each game. These are to be handed in to the host table immediately following the completion of the game.

**Heart and Hustle Award:**

Our tournament committee will be giving out the Heart and Hustle award immediately after each game. Each coaching staff is responsible for choosing their team's recipient of the Heart and Hustle Award. Please have your team's choice ready for announcing directly after each game. Have your team lineup on the respective blue lines immediately following team handshakes. We are going to be tight on time so please do so in a timely matter.
